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University History

The Simon Kuznets Kharkiv National University of Economics (S. Kuznets KhNUE) is widely recognized as one of the leading economic universities in both the Kharkiv region and across Ukraine.

The university has Accreditation level - IV National University Rector - Volodymyr Ponomarenko, Doctor of Economics, Professor Honored Worker of Science and Technology of Ukraine, Corresponding Member of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine.

Founded in 1930 as the Kharkiv Engineering and Economic Institute, the institution originated from the Industrial Faculty of the Kharkiv Institute of National Economy, of which it is the legal successor. In 2013, the university was named in honor of Simon Kuznets (Simon Smith Kuznets), a distinguished economist and Nobel Prize laureate in Economic Sciences (1971), who commenced his academic career in Kharkiv.

Today, the university comprises four Educational and Scientific Institutes: Information Technologies, Economics and Law, International Relations, Management and Marketing, and Faculty of Training for Foreign Citizens. With more than 7,250 students, including 1756 foreign students, studying in 25 specialties, the University is one of the most popular in Kharkiv.



University History

In collaboration with the University of Cambridge, S. Kuznets KhNUE administers the Business English Certificates (BEC) examinations, attaining the status of an independent preparation center for Cambridge University's BEC certification.

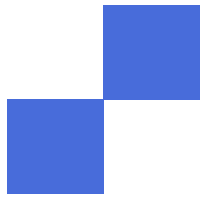

One of the broad aims of this project has been to strengthen the role of higher education in society at large.

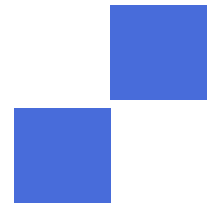
