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The system of evaluation of competences formed by students

The system of evaluation of competences formed by students takes into account the types of studies which include lectures, practical studies and implementation of self-study according to the syllabus of the academic discipline using 100-point scale. The final assessment on the educational discipline accounts marks got during a semester. The total result for a semester makes: "60 and more points: passed", "59 and less points: failed". Minimum possible number of points for current and module control during a semester is 35 points and minimum possible number of points during exam is 25 points.
