Assessment system of learning outcomes

The system of assessment of the formed competencies takes into account the types of classes, which include lectures, laboratory classes, as well as the performance of independent work. Assessment of the formed competencies of students is carried out according to the accumulative 100-point system. The current control carried out during the semester during practical (seminary) classes and independent work is estimated by the sum of points scored. The maximum possible number of points for the current and final control during the semester - 100 and the minimum possible number of points - 60.

Current control includes the following control measures: protection of laboratory works; tasks by topics; current control works; presentations on topics.
