Structural and logical scheme of the academic course



Assessment system

The system of assessment considers points that master students can get in the learning process, including their independent work fulfilment. Current assessment, which is carried out during the semester is estimated by the sum of points scored (the maximum amount is 60, minimum is 35). The results of the exam are assessed in 40 points (the maximum number is 40 points; the minimum number is 25 points). The total result in points for the semester is: "60 or more points – pass", "59 or less points – not pass".
