### **System for assessing learning outcomes**

The system for assessing acquired competencies comprises the different types of class, including lectures, seminars and practical sessions, as well as independent study. Students' acquired competences are assessed using a cumulative 100-point system. Current assessment, carried out throughout the semester during practical sessions and independent study, is graded according to the total number of marks achieved. The maximum attainable marks for in-course evaluations and final examinations throughout the semester is 100, with a minimum threshold of 60. Continuous (formative) assessment includes topic-based assignments, tests, presentations and essay writing.
