- below, centered – **the title of the report** in capital letters, bold;
- below the title, right-aligned – the author's full **surname, first name and patronymic (if any), academic degree and title, position and place of work**, and the **e-mail address** of each author;
- after one blank line – **the text of the abstracts**;
- after one blank line – **the list of references**.
