Discipline policies

Relationships are built on the basis of the principles of mutual respect, exploratory activity and individual approach, provided that the mandatory implementation of educational tasks in accordance with the technological card.

on integrity: The teacher monitors the observance of academic integrity by students and objective assessment of learning outcomes in accordance with the Code of Professional Ethics of Simon Kuznets KhNEU. on attendance: If the student does not provide documents confirming the validity of the reasons for skipping classes (late for classes, leaving the class until the end), then regardless of his explanations, the reason for skipping is considered invalid. In case of non-attendance of the student for a disrespectful reason, the teacher interviews the student on the missed topic or the student can perform an individual scientific or practical task on this topic outside the mandatory tasks on the topic).

on deadlines: In case of performance of tasks later than the established term at the appropriate level the assessment is carried out according to the points provided by the technological card.
