Annotation of the discipline

In the conditions of democratization of the Ukrainian society formation, development and consolidation of new legal thinking, education of the general and legal culture, high professionalism, development of sense of responsibility, justice, respect for the law become especially important. The presence of a high legal culture and legal awareness of citizens is one of the features of the rule of law, and the achievement of such a level is possible only if there is sufficient legal awareness of the population. One of the important parts of this process is the study of the discipline “Law”.

Its study should not only provide students with the basics of knowledge of the theory of state and law, acquaint them with the main categories of other branches of law (constitutional, labor, civil, etc.), but also teach them to apply their knowledge to analyze various, sometimes complex life situations, find solutions that meet the requirements of current legislation.

Purpose of the discipline is to study the general laws of origin, development and functioning of the state and law, the system of basic concepts of jurisprudence, as well as the structure, forms and mechanisms of state and law, the relationship of legal systems, modern political and legal doctrines, etc. Conscious and thorough use of the provisions of constitutional law and other branch of legal sciences in the practice of future professionals.

The subject of the discipline is a set of international intergovernmental relations, i.e. relations between states and other subjects of international law, governed by legally binding treaty and customary rules and principles, which are created to reconcile the common interests of states and provided by voluntary or, if necessary, individual or collective coercion.

As a result of studying the discipline students must **know**:

- the concept of the state and its features;
- characteristics of the form of the state, including the form of the Ukrainian state;
- concepts and elements of the mechanism of the state and the state apparatus;
- basic principles and sources of law;
- the system of law, its elements, the structure of the rule of law;
- current norms of the Constitution of Ukraine and branch's normative and legal acts regulating legal relations;
- concepts, signs and types of offenses, as well as legal liability and its types;
- basics of constitutional law, in particular, the concept and legal properties of the Constitution of Ukraine, the basics of the constitutional and legal status of man and citizen, system, principles of functioning, the order of creation and competence legislative, executive, judicial authorities, as well as law enforcement and human rights bodies;
- basics of the judiciary and principles of administration of justice in Ukraine;
- basics of labor law, in particular, the concept and composition of labor relations, employment contract and contract, grounds for termination of employment contract, material and disciplinary liability, labor disputes;
- basics of civil law, in particular, the characteristics of civil relations, including binding, civil contract and transaction, property and property rights, civil liability;
- the main categories of inheritance law;
- general characteristics of family law and the Family Code of Ukraine;
- the mechanism of protection of the rights and freedoms of the person and the citizen and use of regulatory legal acts.

The student must **be able to**:

- interpret the provisions of the Constitution of Ukraine and other regulations governing legal relations (which are the subject of regulation of certain branches of law);
- solve analytical tasks and practical cases related to the protection of human and civil rights and freedoms, the procedure for concluding employment and civil contracts, etc. ;
- apply the rules of current legislation in addressing specific issues;
- to be guided in definitions and terminology of this or that branch of law in order to use theoretical knowledge in practice competently;

solve specific practical problems using and referring to relevant legal sources, case law.

Content module 1. Theory of state and law. Constitutional law of Ukraine

Topic 1. The theory of state and law. State: basic concepts.

The concept and characteristics of the state. Theories of the origin of the state. Sovereignty. Functions of the state. Forms of realization of state functions. Forms of state: form of government, form of government, political regime. The mechanism (apparatus) of the state. Theory of separation of powers. Constitutional state.

Topic 2. Theory of state and law. Law: basic concepts. Concepts and signs of law. Law in the objective and subjective sense. Functions of law. Law in the system of social norms. Law and morality. Rule of law: concept, structure, types. The system of law. Forms (sources) of law. Laws and bylaws.

Topic 3. Theory of state and law. Legal relations, offenses, legal liability. Legal relations: concepts, signs, composition. Legal facts. Legitimate behavior. Offenses: concepts, signs, types, composition. Legal liability: concepts, grounds, types.

Topic 4. Fundamentals of constitutional law of Ukraine. Citizenship, legal status of a person and a citizen. Constitutional law as a branch of law. Constitutional legal relations. Fundamentals of the constitutional order in Ukraine. The Constitution of Ukraine is the Basic Law of the state. Legal principles of citizenship: concepts, grounds for acquisition and termination. Rights, freedoms and responsibilities of people and citizen.

Topic 5. Fundamentals of constitutional law of Ukraine. The system of public authorities and local self-government. Legal status and powers of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine. Legal status and powers of the President of Ukraine. Legal status and powers of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, central executive bodies and local state administrations. The concept of local self-government. Local governments in Ukraine, their powers.

Judiciary in Ukraine. Justice as a special function of state power. Jurisdiction of the courts. Basic principles of justice in Ukraine. Judicial system of Ukraine. Status of the Constitutional Court of Ukraine. Status of courts of general jurisdiction: structure and competence. Supreme Court. Law enforcement activities. Law enforcement agencies of Ukraine and their functions. Prosecutor's Office of Ukraine. National police. Advocacy of Ukraine. Notary in Ukraine. Legal status of the Security Service of Ukraine.

Content module 2. Fundamentals of labor and civil law of Ukraine

Topic 6. Fundamentals of labor law. Labor and related legal relations. Employment contract. Labor law as a branch of law. Public relations, which is the subject of labor law. Subjects of labor relations. The concept and content of the employment contract. Employment contract as a special form of employment contract. The procedure for concluding an employment contract.

Topic 7. Fundamentals of labor law of Ukraine. Working hours and rest time. Working time: concepts, types, modes of working time. Rest time: concepts, types. Vacations: concepts, types.

Topic 8. Fundamentals of labor law of Ukraine. Disciplinary and material liability. Labor discipline and disciplinary liability. Promotion. Disciplinary sanctions: concepts, types, procedure. Liability of participants in labor relations.

Topic 9. Fundamentals of labor law of Ukraine. Termination of employment. Grounds for termination of employment contract. Grounds for termination of the employment contract at the initiative of the employee. Grounds for termination of the employment contract at the initiative of the owner or his authorized body. Individual and collective labor disputes.

Topic 10. Fundamentals of civil law. Objects and subjects of civil legal relations. Civil law as a branch of law. Principles of civil law of Ukraine. Sources of civil law of Ukraine. Civil legal relations, their classification. Objects of civil law. Subjects of civil law. Individuals as subjects of civil law. Civil legal capacity and legal capacity of individuals. Recognition of a citizen as incapable or partially incapable. Legal entities as subjects of civil law. Types of legal entities.

Topic 11. Fundamentals of civil law of Ukraine. Civil obligations and contracts. Transaction. Commitments: concepts, types. Civil law contracts: concepts, types, procedure for concluding.

Topic 12. Fundamentals of civil law of Ukraine. Property. Civil liability. Inheritance law. Property rights: concept and content. Forms of property rights. Civil law protection of property rights. Civil liability: concepts, types, grounds. Civil offense.

Inheritance law.

Topic 13. Family law. Family law as a branch of law. Marriage: concept and content. The procedure and conditions of marriage. Personal rights and responsibilities of the spouses. Property rights and responsibilities of the spouses. Terms of annulment of marriage. The concept and procedure for termination of marriage. Guardianship and care.

The list of practical (seminar) / laboratory classes, as well as questions and tasks for independent work is given in the table “Rating-plan of the discipline”.

Teaching and learning methods

In the educational process traditional methods are used – verbal (story, explanation, lecture, conversation, discussion, in distance learning – essay, seminar), visual (display: illustration, demonstration presentation), practical (exercises – situational tasks, cases, creative exercises, performance of creative task, research work), control (express-surveys, written control works, final control) and independent (analysis of legal acts).

In addition, dialogical teaching methods are used (methods of activating educational and cognitive actions), in particular, they include analysis of a specific situation, “brainstorming” (“attack”), educational and thematic discussion, business game, professional consultation, etc.

The order of evaluation of the results of training

Evaluation of the developed students competencies is carried out using a 100-point accumulation system. In accordance with the Provisional Regulations “On the Procedure for Evaluating the Results of Student Learning Based on the Accumulated Mark-Rating System” S. Kuznets KhNEU, to the control measures include:

current control during the semester in the course of lectures, practical classes which is estimated by the sum of the points scored (the maximum amount is 60 points; the minimum amount that allows the student to take the exam – 35 points);

modular control, conducted in the form of control work as an intermediate mini-exam on the teacher’s initiative, taking into account the current control over the corresponding content module, and aims at an integrated evaluation of the student's learning outcomes after studying the material from the logically completed part of the discipline content module;

final / semester control, conducted in the form of a semester exam, according to the schedule of the educational process.

In the practical lesson, assessment is carried out for active work in the classroom (0.5 points), during the topic revision (1-2 points) and the quality of situational tasks - problem situations.

The general criteria for evaluating non-auditing independent work of students are: the depth and strength of knowledge, the level of thinking, the ability to systematize knowledge on specific topics, the ability to make informed conclusions, the possession of categorical apparatus, skills and techniques of performing practical tasks, the ability to find the necessary information and legislation, its systematization and processing, self-realization on practical lessons.

Extracurricular independent work involves the implementation of a creative task, which is evaluated in 4 points, and research work by writing a scientific article (estimated at 10 points).

The final control of the knowledge and competences of students in the discipline is carried out on the basis of a semester examination, the task of which is to check the student's understanding of the program material in general, the logic and interrelations between the individual sections, the ability to use the accumulated knowledge creatively, the ability to formulate their attitude to a particular educational problem discipline, etc.

The examination task covers the program of discipline and involves determining the level of knowledge and the degree of mastery of competencies by students.

Each exam task consists of 3 practical situations (one stereotyped, one diagnostic and one heuristic task), which provide for the solution of typical professional tasks of the specialist in the workplace and allow to diagnose the level of theoretical training of the student and his level of competence in the discipline.

The result of the semester exam is evaluated in points (the maximum number is 40 points, the minimum number is scored – 25 points) and is placed in the corresponding column of the examination “Register of the Academic Performance”.

The student should be **considered attested** if the sum of the points earned on the results of the final / semester test of success is equal to or exceeds 60. The minimum number of points for the current and modular control during the semester is 35 and the minimum number of points scored on the exam is 25.

The final score in the discipline is calculated on the basis of the points obtained during the exam and the points obtained during the current control over the accumulation system. The total score in the points for the semester is: “60 and more points are counted”, “59 and less points are not counted” and entered in the “Register of the Academic Performance” of the academic discipline.

The final assessment is set according to the scale given in the table “Assessment scale: national and ECTS”.
