Assessment system

Assessment of students' learning outcomes is carried out by the University according to the cumulative 100-point system.

Current control is carried out during practical (seminar) classes and aims to assess the level of students' readiness to perform particular tasks, and is assessed by the amount of scored



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points.

The maximum amount during the semester -100 points; the minimum amount required is 60 points.

During the teaching of the course, the following control measures are used:

Current control: practical tasks on topics (55 points), written test (maximum score -10 points (two written tests during the semester, total maximum number of points -20 points)), independent work (15 points), and presentation (maximum score -5 points (two presentations during the semester, total maximum number of points -10 points).

Semester control: Grading. More detailed information on assessment and grading system is given in the technological card of the course.
